Shortly after a 2 week missions trip to the Philippines in 2009 Duane & Jenny Newport established Hands of Hope Ministries. After working in San Isidro, Agoo, La Union, for 3 years they started to build Hands of Hope Faith Academy in 2013 and open it for students in 2014

FACILITIES

Hands of Hope Academy are committed to providing classrooms and outdoor facilities that are well maintained and make learning fun. Currently we have facilities and permits to operate Nursery, Kinder, and Grades 1- 6.

Hands of Hope Faith Academy limits classroom sizes to around 20 students. This enables us to give your child the individual support they need to learn.

Outdoor facilities include a basketball and volleyball court, Badminton courts and nets and a large grass area for soccer and other field games.



Hands of Hope Academy facilities also include a computer with 24 laptops, loaded with windows 10 and the latest Microsoft office. Computer classes are taught to all grades , including kinder.

Understanding the School Logo

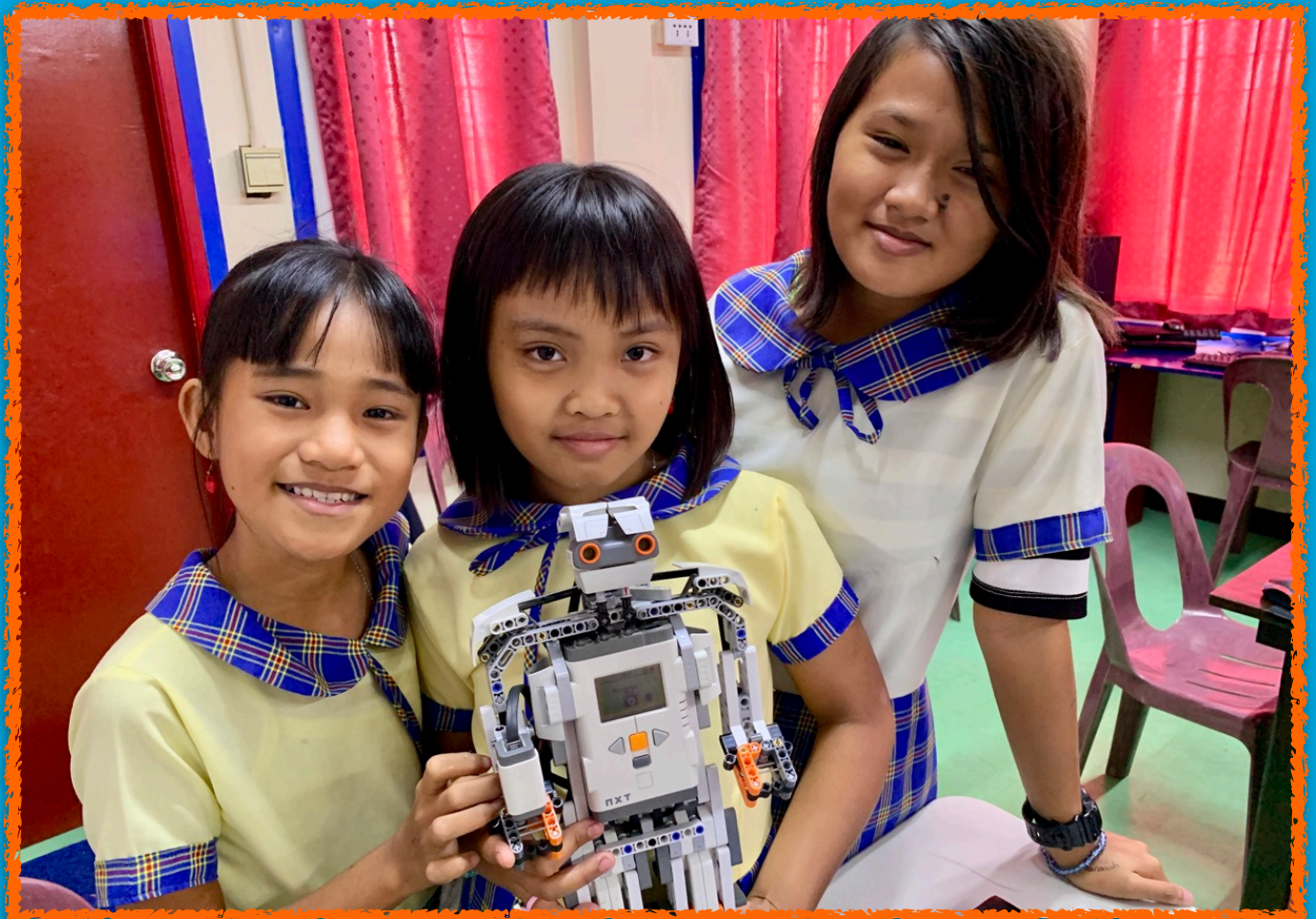

SCHOOL FEES

Hands of Hope fees are heavily subsidised because of its missionary focus. Students are required to bring **220peso** per month which covers, tuition, stationary, library and administration fees and part payment for the uniform. Field trips are not included.

Hands of Hope Faith Academy also provides a nutritional lunch for the students at a cost of **10peso** per day.





WHO CAN APPLY?

Hands of Hope Faith Academy is a private school. School fees are heavily subsidised, 200 peso per month, and this covers tuition, stationary and uniform costs. Applications and Registrations from K to Grade 6 are welcomed for 2019-20SY.

A place at Hands of Hope Faith Academy is not dependent on high academic, sporting, musical and cultural achievement. The candidate is however expected to demonstrate the commitment to achieve to their full potential – whatever level that might be.

Candidates are also expected to have demonstrated the ability to relate well to their peers and to show respect, tolerance and consideration to all. These attributes are very important in a close community such as ours.

All parents/guardians are expected to participate actively in a partnership with the school to empower their child to become the “good and useful” citizen. There is also an expectation that parents/guardians provide a home environment that is aligned to the values upheld by the School.

Hands of Hope Faith Academy is a Christian School and while families of other religions (or of no religion) may apply, they must accept that their child will be educated and will participate in the traditions of the Christian faith whilst at the School.
